**WORSHIP** is a blend of both traditional and contemporary elements that is held at 10:00 a.m. each Sunday.

**RED LANYARDS** are worn by our Ushers and other church leaders so you can easily identify them. They love to help with your questions or concerns!

**USHERS** can guide you to the bathrooms and the children's rooms. If this is your first time worshipping with us, let them know, because we have a gift for you!

**BULLETINS** are available from ushers listing the order of worship to guide you and announcements about upcoming events.

**BIBLES AND HYMNALS** can be found under the seatbacks in front of you.

**REGISTER PADS** are passed each Sunday so you can let us know you were here. We invite you to leave your contact information so we can reach out to you.

**PRAYER REQUEST CARDS** are available in the seat backs in the Sanctuary for prayer requests or to request a call from a pastor

**OFFERING ENVELOPES** in which you may place your offering to God when the offering plate is passed are also in the seat backs.

**COMMUNION AND BAPTISM** The Lord's Supper is celebrated on the last Sunday of each month and on special occasions. Baptisms are celebrated on designated Sundays in coordination with the Pastor and the families. Contact the church office to learn more about scheduling a baptism.

**SUNDAY SCHOOL** for all ages is available at 9:00 a.m. on Sunday mornings September through May. Children, Youth, and Adults all have age appropriate lessons that revolve around the same scripture each week.

**NURSERY** is available for children age 4 and under. Please pick your child up immediately following worship.

**CHILDREN'S CHURCH** is available for older children after they attend the first portion of worship with you. At the announced time, children will come forward for a prayer and then be led to room 108 where they will be led in their own lesson, games, and singing. Please pick your child up immediately following worship. **ACTIVITY BAGS** are available for those children who choose to remain in worship.
